### Cook with your family! Do you want to make a Ginaerbread Man?



Stepsa

- 1. Place softened butter in a large mixing bowl.
- 2. Add brown sugar and mix it until butter and sugar are creamed together.
- 3. Add some honey.
- 4. Add one egg and flour into the mixture.
- 5. Add baking soda, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg, clove and ginger. Mix them well.
- Form the mixture into a ball.
- Cover the ball with plastic wrap and chill for at least 2 hours.
- 8. Separate the dough into two sections.
- 9. Roll the sections until they're 1.4 inch thick
- 10. Using a Gingerbread man shape cutter and cut the sections into shapes.
- 11. Bake the cookies.
- 12. Cool on a wire rack until they are completely cool.
